	<p>The applicant has sought the relief of cancellation of the written examination held on 29.10.2017 for the post of Primary Teacher (Post Cost 16/17). There were serious allegations of paper leakage and use of electronic devices for cheating in the examination and other acts of misfeasance, malfeasance committed by the authorities in allowing some candidates in entering the examination hall after the time for entry. The applicant has also placed on record copy of an FIR No. 0103 registered on 29.10.2017. In this regard there is a Press Release issued on 30.10.2017 by the Police. Apart from that there are News Reports also.</p> <p>It is also mentioned that the Deputy Chief Minister, Delhi has written a letter to the Lt. Governor on 29.10.2017 for cancellation of the written examination but nothing has been done till date. The applicant has also placed on record C.D. containing videography of the candidates jumping the wall.</p> <p>Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations, prima-facie, committed during the Examination, we direct the Respondent No.2 to submit a detailed report in respect to the allegations made in this OA before this Tribunal within</p>

three weeks.

Respondent No.6 Delhi Police is also directed to produce the status report of the investigation conducted within three weeks. Till the matter is further examined, Respondent No.2 will not declare the result of the examination held on 29.10.2017 for the post of Primary Teacher (Post Code 16/17).
