
Pursuant to Annexure A-1 Advertisement No. 02/17 of Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board (DSSSB) dated 07.08.2017 inviting applications for various posts including the post of Special Educator (Primary) MCD (Post Code - 15/17), the applicants applied for the said post well before the closing date of receipt of applications, i.e. 15.09.2017. As per the qualifications prescribed for the said post, candidates applying for the post, *inter alia*, should also possess CTET qualification.

- 2. The contention of the applicants is that CTET examination has not been held by the CBSE since September, 2016 and as such, they did not get opportunity to appear in it. The applicants, however, have applied for CTET notified by CBSE during the current year, i.e. 2018.
- 3. As an interim relief, the applicants have sought a direction to the respondents not to insist on CTET qualification and to allow them to participate in the selection process.
- 4. It is stated that the applicants have cleared written examination and have been shortlisted. The shortlisted

candidates are required to upload their e-dossiers, the last date for which is 26.09.2018. Mr. Anuj Aggarwal, learned counsel submits that the applicants tried to upload their e-dossiers but online system has not accepted it, apparently due to the applicants not possessing CTET qualification. Accordingly, the applicants have sought interim relief by way of a direction to the respondents to accept the e-dossiers of the applicants provisionally.

- 5. Issue notice. Mr. Anuj Kumar Sharma, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 2 (DSSSB).
- 6. Heard learned counsel for the parties briefly.
- 7. Taking into consideration the fact that the applications for the post of Special Educator (Primary) MCD (Post Code No.15/17) of these applicants had been accepted by DSSSB and they were also allowed to participate in the written examination even though they do not possess CTET qualification and also keeping in view the fact that CTET Examination has not been held by CBSE since September, 2016 and that CBSE has notified CTET Examination, 2018 to which the applicants have already applied, we direct respondent No. 2 (DSSSB) to accept the e-dossiers of the applicant provisionally. If for any technical reasons, the e-dossiers of the applicants cannot be accepted online, in that case respondent No. 2 shall accept their e-dossiers off-line. Such provisional participation shall not confer any right or equity in favour of the applicants. The result of the applicants shall be kept in a sealed cover and shall not be declared without leave of the Tribunal.
